Cothill House is an independent full boarding school for approximately 200 boys aged 8–13 years situated in Cothill, near Abingdon. The school Medical Centre is located at the heart of the school and provides a 24-hour nursing service for pupils. The school GPs hold twice weekly surgeries in the school and they are also on call to deal with emergencies.

We require a qualified School Nurse to join our dedicated and professional team of nurses and matrons. This position is part time, term-time only working a combination of weekday, evening, Saturday shifts. The total weekly hours may vary during the term, but approximately 26 hours per week will be required. On-site parking is available and a free meal is provided.

The successful candidate will have an interest or experience in working with children. Previous Practice or School Nursing experience would be an advantage although not essential. The ability to work independently is essential and responsibilities include correspondence with parents, Covid testing and dealing with emergencies.
